People are SHOCKED and worried about the state of our economy. They feel let down by both the Government and our Conservative councils.

## Labour failure

Residents have had enough of a Labour Government that has encouraged casino-style banking, a false boom based on inflated house prices and covered up a broken political system.

Prospective Lib Dem MP Denzil Coulson said, "MPs are resigning before they are voted out. Some are ashamed of their track record and lavish expense claims. Britain needs a fresh start in politics, and Fleet North needs a local champion who will stand up for local people."

## "Sixty year mistake"

Many are far from convinced by the Conservatives. Few trust a party which backed Labour over the war in Iraq, which called for less regulation in the City, and caused controversy last summer when one of their leading

MEPs called the NHS a "60-year mistake."

And residents have seen the quality of local services decline under Conservatives at Hart and Hampshire, and now face high charges, services under threat and money being wasted.

A Labour Minister approved the Pyestock development without even visiting the site! Planners at Tory-led Hart initially recommended approval of outline plans for Pyestock early in 2006 and it took a huge campaign by local residents, aided by Lib Dem councillors, to force the council to oppose it.

## We need real change

Denzil Coulson added, "Our area needs an MP who is a local champion. Someone who is honest about the choices we must make."

"The Lib Dems believe we need decent value-for-money services locally and tax cuts for people on ordinary incomes. The Conservatives' priority is a tax cut for millionaires. This is not the change Britain needs."
